Garantie de résidence

Guaranteed Single Residence Rooms for All First-Year Students

We guarantee a single room in residence to all first-year students who apply directly from high school and pay their deposit prior to the residence application deadline.

You must apply by June 3, 2019, with a refundable \$500 deposit, plus a \$50 non-refundable application fee.

Washroom facilities are shared.</p> <p>Townhouse-style residences offer the convenience of on-campus living, with a more independent lifestyle. You will share a unit with 2, 3 or 4 other students and have the option to cook your own meals.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All rooms in Quarry View Residence are singles. • There is one double room and three single rooms in each Village Residence unit. • Townhouse-style residences also feature a kitchen, living area and 2 bathrooms per house.

Résidence de l'est

La nouvelle Résidence est est une édifice de 12 étages hébergeant 236 personnes dans des appartements autonomes. Chaque appartement a 3 ou 4 chambres pour 1 personne, 1 salon, 1 cuisine et 2 salles de bain.

Résidence ouest

La Résidence ouest est un édifice de 6 étages avec système de climatisation et ascenseur. Cinq étages sont réservés au logement. Le rez-de-chaussée est occupé par la buanderie, des machines distributrices, des toilettes publiques, des salles d'étude, une aire de cueillette du courrier, le Bureau des résidences, des aires de service, une salle à ordures, une salle pour le recyclage, etc.

La Résidence ouest loge 220 membres du corps étudiant des années supérieures dans 55 appartements meublés et indépendants comptant chacun 4 chambres simples, 1 salon, 1 cuisine et 2 salles de bain. La télévision par câblodistribution dans chaque appartement, 1

connexion à internet près de chaque lit et 1 prise de téléphone dans chaque pièce sont offertes sans frais supplémentaires. Il y a aussi 1 salle de télévision et 1 vide-ordure à chaque étage. Toutes les entrées, dont l'accès s'effectue au moyen d'une carte, sont munies d'une caméra de surveillance.

Résidence des étudiants célibataires

La Résidence des étudiants célibataires comprend 3 ailes comportant chacune 3 étages. Cet édifice peut loger 387 étudiantes et étudiants dans 54 appartements à 4 chambres à coucher pouvant loger 6 personnes chacune, et 18 appartements à 2 chambres à coucher pouvant loger 4 personnes. Chaque appartement compte 1 salle à manger, salon, 1 cuisine comportant 1 cuisinière et 1 réfrigérateur, 2 salles de bain et 1 salle d'entreposage.

Résidence du collège universitaire

La Résidence du collège universitaire est une tour de 11 étages où peuvent loger 240 étudiantes et étudiants. Elle comprend 60 chambres à 1 lit et 90 chambres à 2 lits.
